THURSDAY

Arrive Napoli Airport, Transfer to Pozzuoli, Embark for Capri

We greet your flight at the Naples airport to transfer for 30 minutes by luxury vehicle to the **Pozzuoli** harbor to the west of Naples in the Phlegraean Fields. This area of 24 volcanic craters, some still steaming today, was the mythological home of Hades and entrance to the underworld. Settlements in this area go back to Greek times, and it was famous in Roman times for pozzolana, the seemingly magical construction material of volcanic glass dust that allowed Roman concrete to be strong enough to build an empire.

Your crew welcomes you on board the Blue Deer with appetizers and drinks, and by midday we start our 3 hour navigation to **Capri** across the Bay of Naples always under the watchful gaze of Vesuvius.

Enjoy lunch on board as you retrace the sea routes of Odysseus and the Roman emperor Tiberius as he sailed to his villa on Capri. Arriving near this beautiful island, we circumnavigate Capri, taking in the stunning views from the sea that become more fascinating with each turn.

We anchor near the Faraglioni Rocks, one of the most romantic and evocative spots of Capri, and a beautiful place for an evening swim.

Enjoy dinner on board tonight, created by our chef from the freshest, local ingredients and served with some of the most flavorful wines from the area.

FRIDAY From Capri to Nerano

Awake this morning to a homemade breakfast on board of all your favorites. Ready for the day, we momentarily trade our boat for one of the fun, open-aired taxis found only here on Capri for a **morning drive** to explore her highlights such as the Villa San Michele, Capri town, Anacapri, and many points in between.

There are **fabulous treks** on Capri, and some may wish to go off the beaten path and see the wild, natural side of this surprisingly diverse island on foot. Our historical guide this day will organize the best way to accommodate your wishes with the plethora of options.

We will all meet up for lunch at a typical restaurant with a fantastic view of Vesuvius and renown for its caprese ravioli. Then we descend to the sea again and board the Blue Deer to set a course for **Nerano**. This is one of the most beautiful sections of the Amalfi Coast with a wild coastline of tranquil bays and typical Mediterranean plants, many flowering or perfumed. Nerano's name came from its most

famous visitor in ancient times, the emperor Tiberius (Tiberio Nerone), who built a villa here to compliment his 12 villas on Capri. Still today, this tranquil bay hosts VIPs and movie stars who come for the lovely surroundings and the fabulous fish restaurants found here.

This is the perfect place to swim and enjoy the sea. Perhaps we will go by dinghy to the stunning **Baia di leranto**, a protected bay whose calm waters team with sea life that is fun to discover snorkeling.

This evening we taste some of our favorite fish dishes at one of the classic restaurants in the marina of Nerano. Tonight at anchor in this lovely spot.











SATURDAY

From Nerano to Positano and the Amalfi Coast

Start again today with a plentiful breakfast on board, prepared by our wonderful chef. Then you have two options: one on the sea and one on the land. For the sporty in the group, we propose an **electric bike ride** on the stunning coastal road that leads from Nerano to Positano. It is a challenging ride, but becomes intermediate level on the electric bikes and thoroughly fun! You will experience some of the most incredible views over the coast as you climb from the Sorrento peninsula and then descend to the classic route to **Positano**. Your biking guide will make sure you are comfortable on the bikes, and we will provide drinks and snacks along the way.

For those who would like to enjoy the sea today, the Blue Deer will sail to the famous **Siren Islands** (Isole Li Galli), where Odysseus faced the dangerously beautiful sirens, whose song could bring ruin to him and his crew. From Positano, the islands look like a mermaid laying in the sea, but in fact they make a circular shape that provided a safe harbor for the Romans.

We will take a spin around the islands, and then anchor in a good spot for swimming and taking in the view of the islands' chapel and villa, once the retreat of dancer Rudolf Nureyev.

We meet again together in **Positano** to enjoy lunch at one of the fun restaurants there and perhaps shop in the many artisanal boutiques lining the charming narrow streets. After lunch feel free to return to the boat for a swim and relax.

Late afternoon we sail toward **Amalfi**, during the Middle Ages one of the most important maritime republics in Italy (with Venice, Pisa, and Genova). The sea merchants here traded with many towns in North Africa, and our private guide will explain how this influenced the architecture to create a unique style. As we enter the old city, the shock of the cathedral covered in exuberant decoration rising above us immediately makes one feel the drama and power of this place. The bones of the apostle Saint Andrew are kept here, and there are many









treasures of gold and silver to see inside the church, including a beautiful Arabic cloister. Today, Amalfi is the place to experience the **famous lemons** of the Amalfi Coast, be it with a sip of limoncello or a scoop of lemon gelato, and we will do our best to try them all! This evening we return to the Blue Deer for dinner with a view of the lights of Amalfi. Tonight at anchor.




SUNDAY From the Amalfi Coast to POMPEII, then NAPOLI

After breakfast on board, we lazily explore the sea near **Amalfi** to find the best spot to swim and for photos of the charming villages along the shore. There are a number of typical fish restaurants in this area, and we will try one of the best for lunch.

After lunch we say goodbye to the Blue Deer and our crew near Amalfi to hop in our private vehicle and travel 1.5 hours to **Pompeii**, where we will have a private guided tour. These fascinating ruins were buried in the eruption

Our exploration of Capri, the Amalfi Coast, and Pompeii complete, we head back to the airport in Naples for flights home. We hope to welcome you on the **Blue Deer** again soon.
